Ronald was inducted into the U.S.M.C. on August 23, 1982, spending 3 months in basic training. He then trained as a Combat Engineer, attaining the rank of Pfc. on February 1st. Ron was awarded Honor Graduate and promoted to Lance Corporal on February 2nd. He was assigned to Camp Pendleton, CA for 1 year and transferred to Okinawa, Japan where he was stationed for 1 year (7 months of that time was in Korea on two operations). He finished his 4-year duty at Camp Pendleton, CA, attaining the rank of Corporal. Ron received the Good Conduct Medal, including several ribbons and was honorably discharged on August 23, 1986.
